Steps to Apply to the University of Arizona Fred Fox School of Music

1. Apply to The University of Arizona through the Office of Admissions: [Apply Online](http://www.arizona.edu/future-students) <<http://www.arizona.edu/future-students>> or call 520-621-3237.
2. Submit a [Fred Fox School of Music Application](https://app.getacceptd.com/arizonamusic) <<https://app.getacceptd.com/arizonamusic>> and take an [audition](http://music.arizona.edu/index.php/admissions/auditions/) <<http://music.arizona.edu/index.php/admissions/auditions/>> on your principal instrument or voice with a faculty reviewing panel. For scholarship consideration, you must audition by April 1.
3. Perform at an acceptable level, receive your official UA acceptance notification, and you are a Music Major.

For your information

- It is strongly suggested that Pima music students participate in applied studio instruction (MUP 161-278), however placement and direct equivalency at the UA Fred Fox School of Music is determined through audition only. Likewise, it is suggested that Pima music students participate in appropriate large conducted ensembles (MUS 116, 120, 130, 131) every semester while at Pima.
- Because of the sequential nature of UA music classes, there may be times when there is a limit to how many music classes a student can be taking in a given semester. In these cases, students will need to use their enrollment in general education classes to maintain their full-time status. - Pima Community College offers MUS 103 (Music Theory Review) or “Theory Boot Camp” the second or third week of the fall and spring semesters. This 2-day music theory review session is designed help music students that might need to brush up on foundational theory skills in order to be successful the first semester theory that is required of music majors. The UA Fred Fox School of Music strongly suggests that ALL music students consider this review opportunity in music theory.
